







The pie chart shows the **percentage** of **PEPE JEANS**' **women's jeans styles** on **discount** for the **month** of **September 2024**.

Note : Any article which might be at the highest price is considered as the highest price and similarly for the lowest priced article.



PEPE JEANS' product range demonstrates the **brand** is embracing modern **fabric compositions** by the use of **Polyester** along with **Elastane**. This indicates a responsive approach to consumer demands for both **quality** and **comfort denim**. As **comfort** and durability becomes increasingly important in **fashion**, **Pepe Jeans'** varied **fabric compositions** position them well to cater to evolving market preferences.



Note: Fits can often be overlapping. Eg a jean might be tight at the thighs and boot cut at the bottom. We have considered only the one which is the more prominently focused on by the brand without considering overlaps.


The distribution of **fits** in **women's jeans styles** reveals a clear consumer preference for **Slim/Skinny Fit**, which dominates the **fits** with **43%** of the **total styles**. This reflects a strong inclination towards a more **fitted silhouette**, catering to consumers who prefer a sleek and modern look. **Boot Cut** comes in second at **30%**, indicating a significant demand for this versatile **fit**, known for its balance between **comfort** and **style**.

Straight Fit ranks **third**, accounting for **19%** of the market share, showcasing a continued preference for classic, timeless **silhouettes**. **Relaxed Fit** and **Tapered Fit** both hold **3%**, indicating more niche preferences for these **comfortable** yet less prominent **styles**. **Loose Fit** stands at **2%**, while **Cargo styles** represent just **1%** of the total, confirming that these **fits** remain minor players in the overall **fit** landscape.



An analysis of the **rises** in **women's jeans styles offered** by **Pepe Jeans** in **September 2024** reveals that **High Rise** is the dominant trend, aligning with the **latest denim** market preferences.

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


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

The significant incorporation of **polyester** in about **67%** of **Pepe women's jeans** indicates a strategic shift towards enhancing the durability, elasticity, and overall performance of **denim**. This trend reflects a consumer preference for practical, versatile clothing that aligns with modern **lifestyle** needs. While polyester offers benefits such as improved shape retention and colorfastness, it is crucial to consider its environmental impact. The continued use of blended **fabrics** like polyester suggests that **PEPE** is effectively adapting to market demands, balancing traditional **denim qualities** with contemporary material innovations.



While traditional denim production relied heavily on **100% cotton**, **Pepe Jeans'** modern approach in the **Indian market** shows a clear shift towards a blend of **materials**, with **cotton** still being the dominant component at around **83%**. However, the increasing use of synthetic **fibres**, such as **polyester** (**14%**), reflects a growing trend of incorporating performance-enhancing **materials**.

This blend indicates a response to market demands for durability, **stretch**, and **sustainability**. **Polyester**, which enhances **strength** and **longevity**, constitutes a significant portion of the **material composition**, while elastane (**1.3%**) and lycra (**0.3%**) are introduced for **flexibility**, contributing to the **comfort** and **stretch** of the **jeans**.

Notably, the inclusion of **fibres** such as **viscose** (**1.1%**) and **ecovero** (**0.3%**), both of which are sustainable alternatives, highlights the **brand's** efforts towards **eco-conscious** production. The trace presence of **nylon** (**0.1%**), **elastomultiester** (**0.2%**), and other **materials** further exemplifies a growing trend toward **multi-fiber blends**, which are increasingly popular for offering enhanced **functionality** and **sustainability** benefits.

As the **denim** industry evolves, a focus on balancing performance, **sustainability**, and cost efficiency will be crucial for **brands** like **Pepe Jeans** to stay competitive in both **local** and **global markets**.

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
